Birthdays are always fun to celebrate. As NISRA wraps up its 49th year of providing community-inclusive therapeutic recreation services and enriching lives, we look forward to the new year as the Association hits the "big Five-O." We're celebrating 50 years of service on March 9, 2026!

On March 9, 1976, four park districts—Cary, Crystal Lake, Huntley, and Marengo—signed a resolution forming the Northern Illinois Special Recreation Association. That fall, the first six seasonal recreation programs were offered, and the NISRA administrative office was a desk and chair in the Crystal Lake Park District Main Beach Pavilion.

From these humble beginnings, NISRA's membership has grown to eight park districts and five municipalities, annually offering over 900 special recreation programs and engaging more than 7,600 seasonal program registrations. In addition to utilizing member district/department recreation facilities and other commercial facilities, the NISRA administrative office in Crystal Lake developed the Sage Therapeutic Recreation Center, featuring a Snoezelen® sensory room, teaching kitchen, music room, art studio, and large multipurpose community room.

With this fast-approaching momentous milestone, we pause to give thanks to the people and organizations who have provided support through the years, and to those who continue to support NISRA's mission to enrich the lives of people with disabilities through meaningful recreation experiences. Thank you to member districts and municipalities, all staff and volunteers, collaborative organizations, and NISRA Foundation supporters and sponsors.

Most importantly, thank you to program participants and their families/caregivers for giving us your trust that the organization will always live up to its five core values of FUN, PROFESSIONAL, COMPASSIONATE, TRUSTWORTHY, and INNOVATIVE.

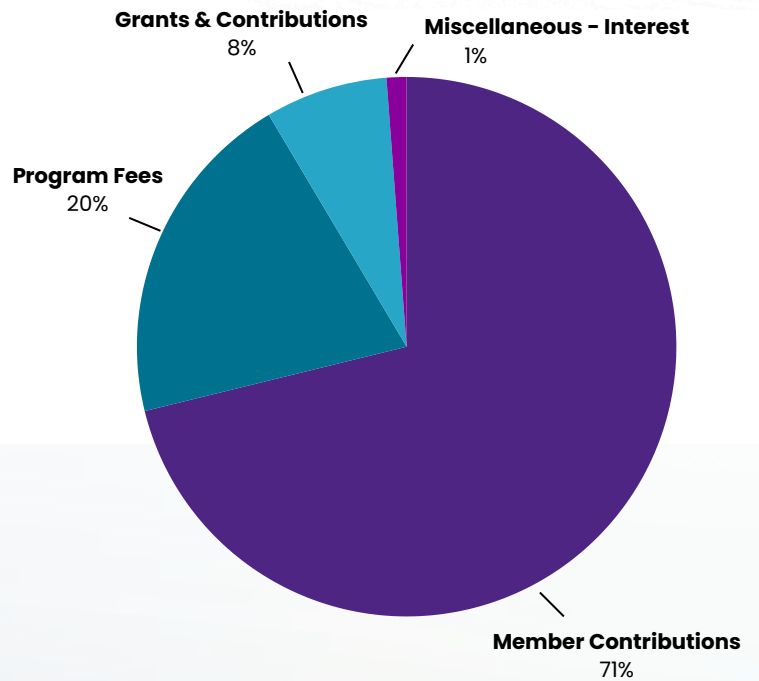

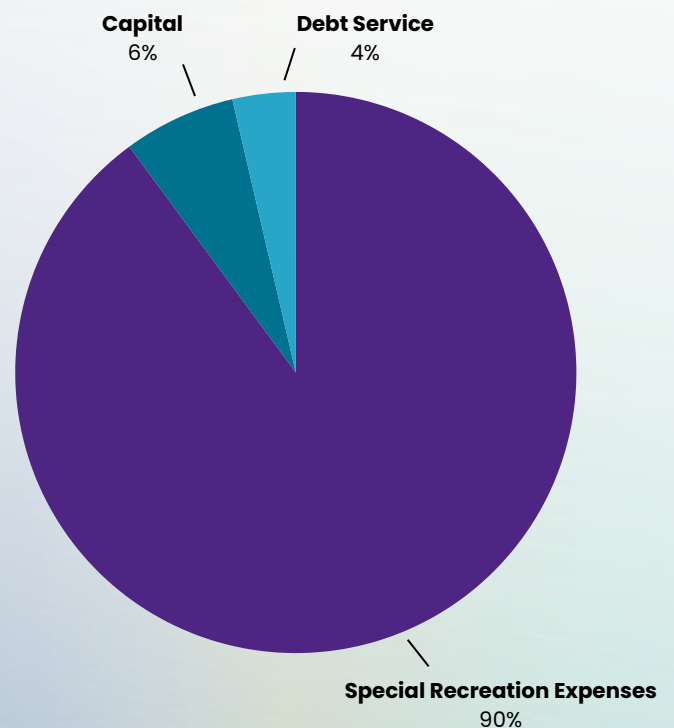

HIGHLIGHTS & ACHIEVEMENTS

Since 1976, NISRA has provided year-round recreation activities for local children, teens and adults with disabilities. These noteworthy highlights and achievements occurred during NISRA and the NISRA Foundation's fiscal year May 2024 – April 2025.

THIS PAST YEAR WE...

Expanded Horizons: Participants explored the world beyond their communities with unforgettable travel experiences to Duluth, MN; Indianapolis, IN; and Mesa, AZ.

Grew Through New Experiences: Launched inclusive new programs that build confidence, connection, and independence like from rock climbing, rowing to sailing, gymnastics, cultural arts, and sensory-friendly family offerings—made possible through meaningful community partnerships with *North Wall*, *Community Sailing School at Pistakee*, *Cary Gymnastics*, *Encore Music Academy* and *Sweeps & Sculls Rowing*.

Shined With Center Stage Moments: NISRA's Theater Troupe cast shined in the production of Disney's *Moana Jr.*, celebrating creativity, confidence, and the power of inclusive performing arts.

The NISRA Silver Knights Basketball Team are Special Olympics STATE CHAMPIONS! To top it off, Michael, a NISRA Knight, nailed a buzzer-beater 3-pointer to end the second game of the tournament.

Supported Family Togetherness: Offered a wide range of family-focused programs that brought joy, fun, and shared experiences creating memories with karaoke and brunch, family summer events with the Village of Lake in the Hills and Huntley Park District, to open gym, a visit to the Milwaukee Zoo and hayrides.

Expanded the NISRA Team: Added a full-time Registration Specialist to better serve participants and families, ensuring a smoother, more supportive registration experience.

Exceeded in Stewardship: Awarded the GFOA Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting for FY ending April 30, 2024—an agency-wide accomplishment reflecting years of dedication to transparency, accountability, and fiscal responsibility.

Met Growing Demand: All three LIFE Program sites—Crystal Lake, Huntley, and Carpentersville—remained at full capacity with active waitlists, underscoring the critical need and impact of these services.

Evolved Veteran Services: Transitioned to a fully NISRA-led program under the new name Veterans Fitness and Fellowship, continuing to support veterans through fitness, connection, skill-building, and community—while honoring past partnerships and embracing future growth.



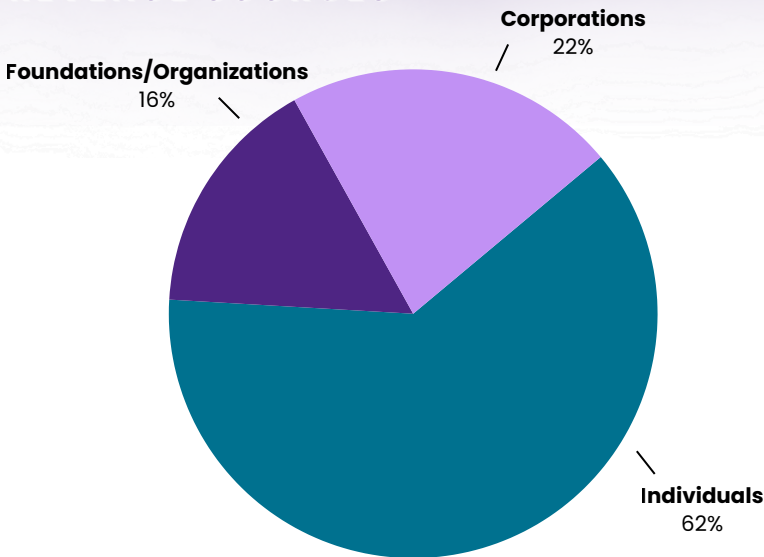

Created in 1991, The NISRA Foundation raises funds to support some of NISRA's unique programs and capital projects.

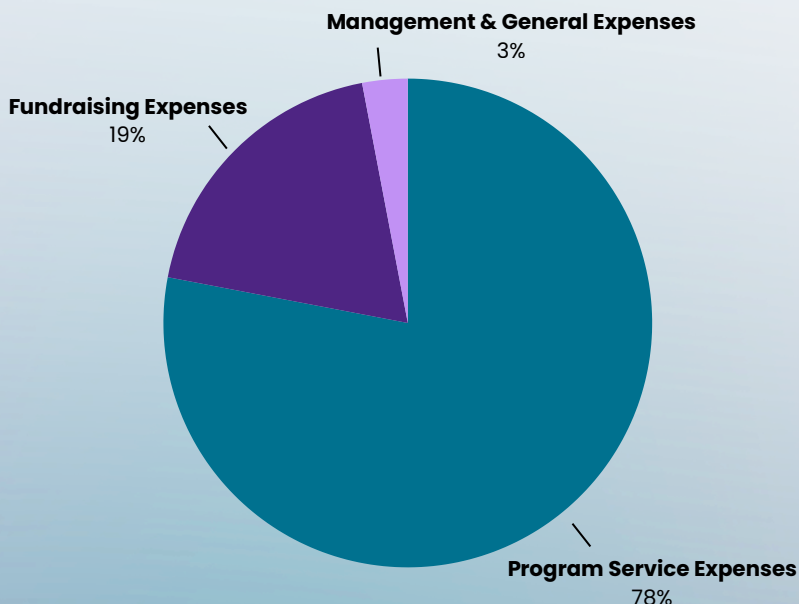
