


## Q1 Do you, or does someone in your household or daily life, experience a disability?



## Q2 Which NISRA member District or Community do you reside in?



### Q3 Have you visited the NISRA office/Sage Therapeutic Recreation Center in Crystal Lake within the past six months?





## Q5 On a scale of 1-3, how would you rate the overall accessibility of the NISRA office building/Sage Therapeutic Recreation Center?


