

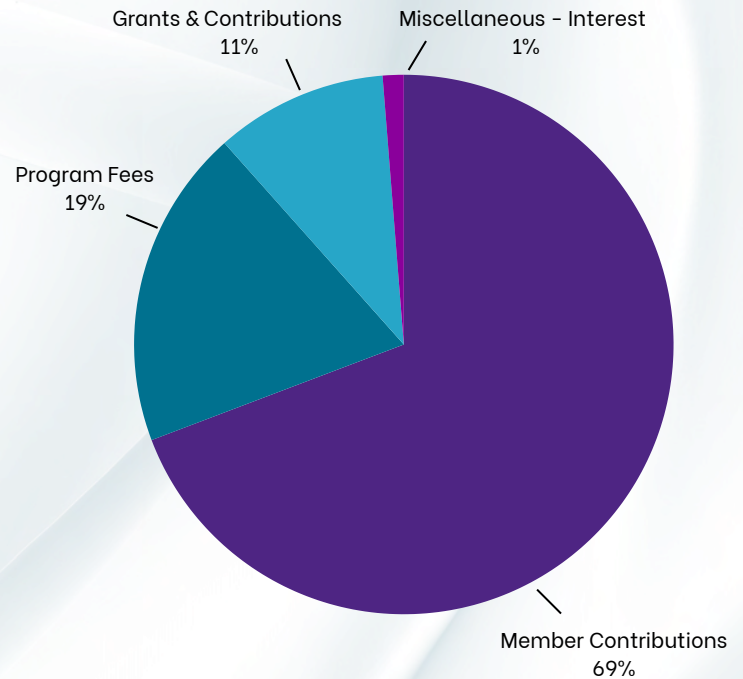

## NISRA Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Fund Net Assets: Year Ended April 30, 2024

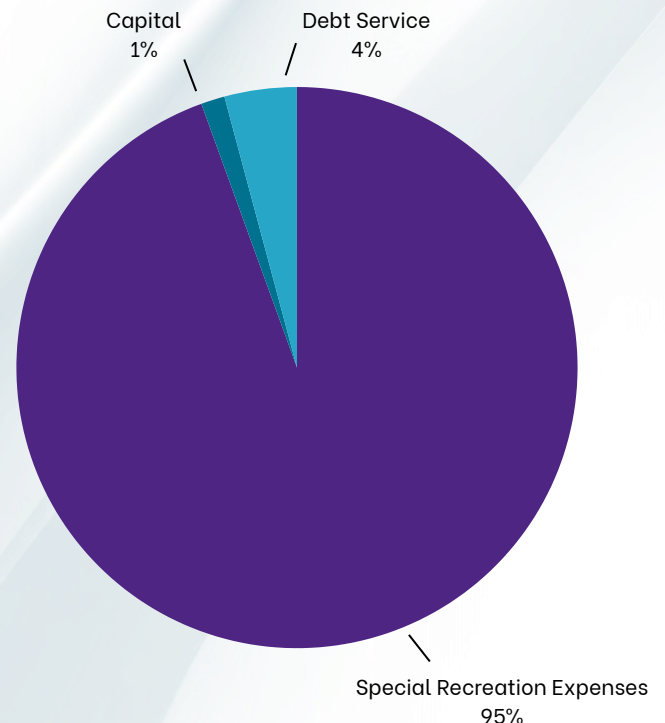

# HIGHLIGHTS & ACHIEVEMENTS

Since 1976, NISRA has provided year-round recreation activities for local children, teens and adults with disabilities. These noteworthy highlights and achievements occurred during NISRA and the NISRA Foundation's fiscal year May 2023 - April 2024.

## REFLECT & REVISIT...

- NISRA staff and participants traveled to South Haven, Michigan and the Wisconsin Dells (twice!) for adult camping trips offering adventure and relaxation in the great outdoors
- We hosted our 30th Annual Recognition Night honoring participants, staff, community members, and donors for their dedication to NISRA services
- The NISRA Foundation hosted sellout events drawing in enthusiastic crowds creating unforgettable experiences including the Spring Shoot Out, Women's Golf Outing and Holiday Fashion Show
- NISRA's summer day camps provided summertime fun for 100 participants, serving more than the previous year and providing more camp staff opportunities
- New programs were offered each season such as: Addams Family Musical, Adaptive Dance, Concerts in the Park, Dance Lessons, Snoezelen Room Passes, Jumpin' Gymnastics, Adaptive Self Defense, Farmer's Market Tuesdays, Coffee Around Town, Bell Choir, Group Music Therapy, Sensory Art, Flag Football Camp, Conversation Cruisers, Cooking Club, and Just Keep Rowing
- Various family programs were offered that included: a pool party, bowling, movie night, beach party, holiday light tour, planetarium show, brunch and karaoke, and a hayride and bonfire night
- NISRA's Theater Troupe delivered vibrant and exceptional performances bringing Disney's Finding Nemo to life in a dazzling fall production and showcasing Making the Band: A 90's Tribute, an original script written by Emily Todd
- Made updates and purchased new equipment for the The Snoezelen Sensory Room received new equipment and updates were made to enhance sensory experiences
- NISRA's Veterans Programs partnered with Veterans Pathway to Hope to provide and serve more Veterans with recreation, social, and family opportunities

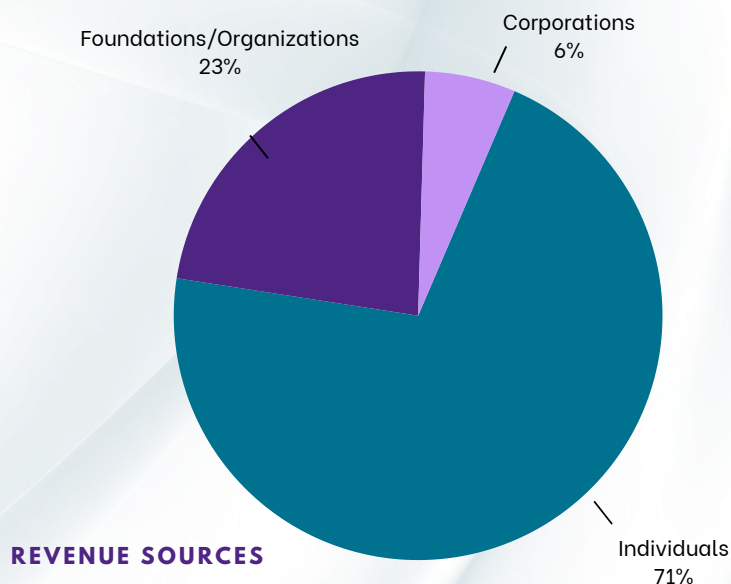

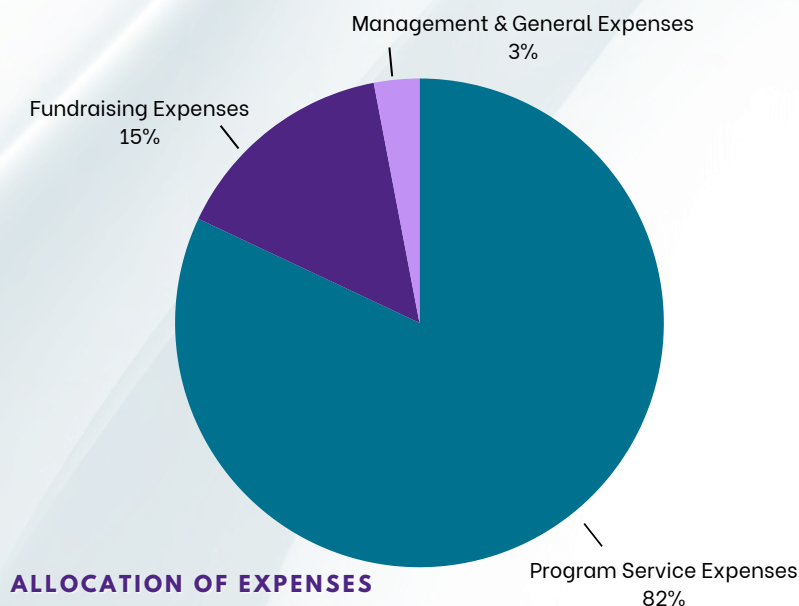
